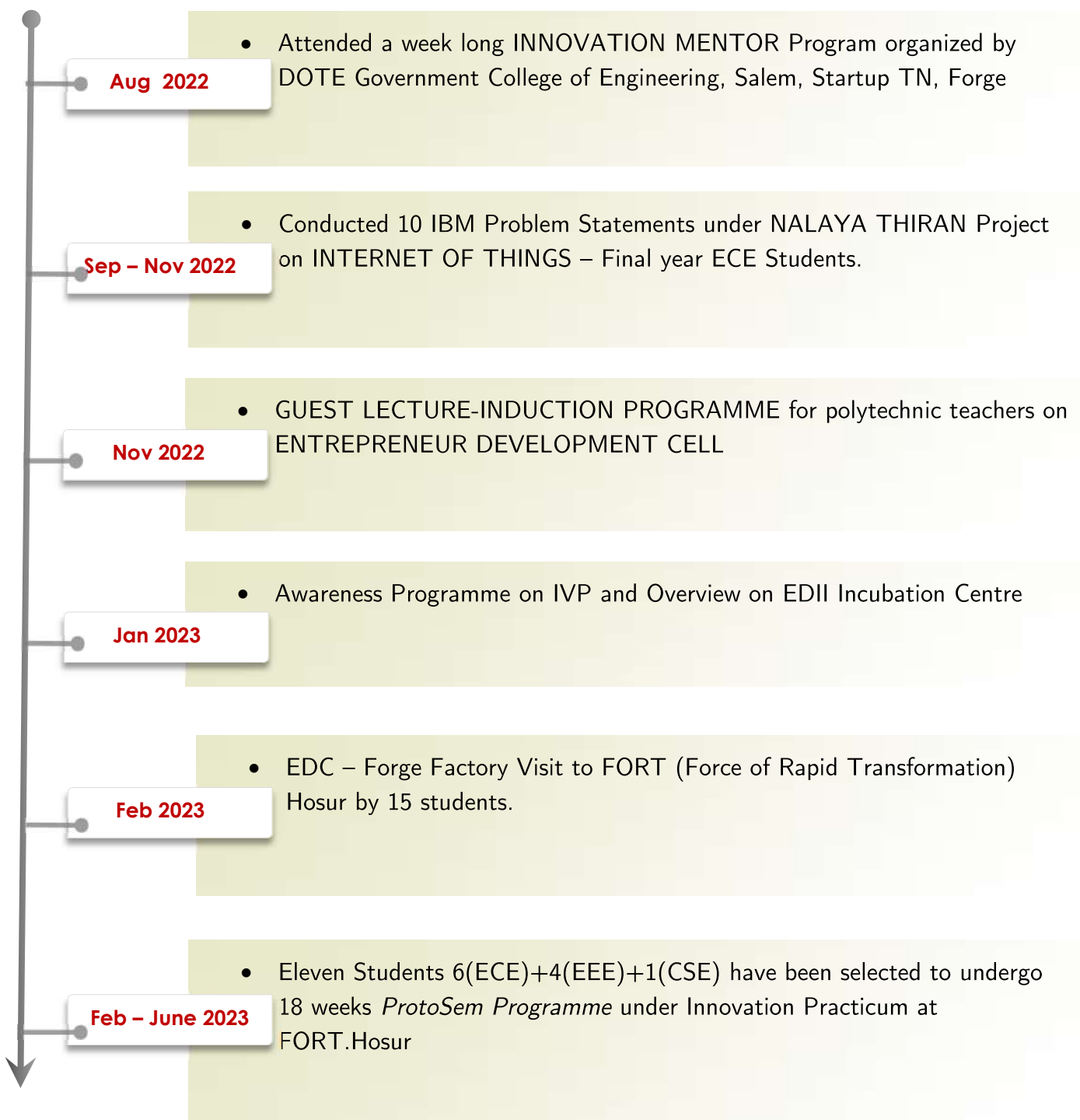

1. INNOVATION MENTOR Programme

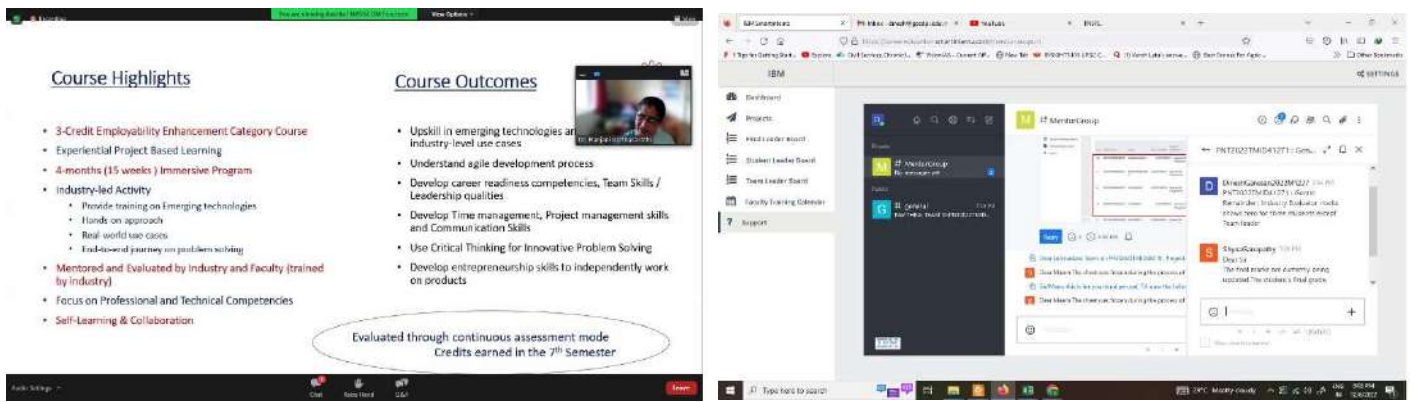

6. Eleven Students - 18 weeks *ProtoSem Programme* under Innovation Practicum at FORT. Hosur

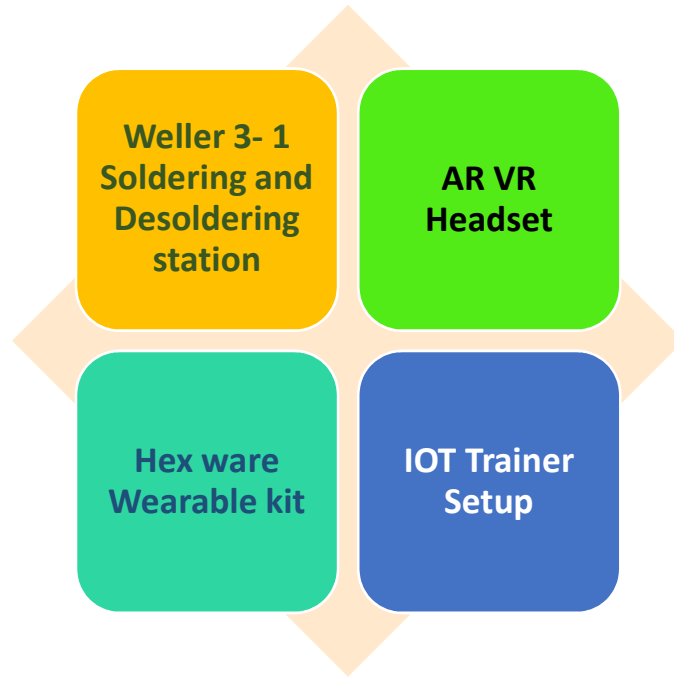
Place of Internship: FORT. Hosur
